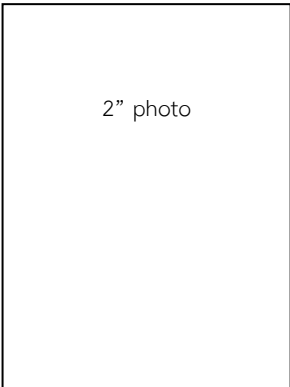

Regulations for the 4th NIDA ASEAN CAMP

1. Students must cooperate and follow safety recommendations from the Camp advisors and officers.
2. Students must dress politely, with dark-toned color clothes, in order to honor the location.
3. Students must always hang their name cards throughout the camping time.

Applicant’s qualification for “the 4th NIDA ASEAN CAMP”

1. Third or fourth year university students who are studying in universities under the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC) and Association of Southeast Asian Institutions of Higher Learning (ASAIHL).
2. Maintain minimum of 2.75 GPAX or under the discretion of “the 4th NIDA ASEAN CAMP” team.
3. Students must be able to participate the whole session.
4. Students must be healthy, with no severe contagious diseases.
5. Students must be fully willing to participate in all activities, open to learn and ready to share experiences together.

Required items for applying

1. Completed application form with an 2 inches photo.
2. Letter from advisor.
3. Certified copy of transcript
4. Certified copy of student ID
5. Certified copy of ID/passport

Remarks: Students who send scanned documents via email or fax must submit certified hardcopy documents by 26 June 2017.

Items to prepare for the Camp
